COMPLETE A FORM EACH TIME (NOT RECOMMENDED)

Under new 'SuperStream' legislation, all employers with more than 20 employees must submit contributions electronically. If you have 20 or less employees, contributions can be made by completing the 'Ongoing employer contribution' form each time you make super contributions on behalf of your employees. The form is available at australianethical.com.au/employers

SUPERANNUATION CLEARING HOUSE

Some payroll or accounting providers offer superannuation clearing house services. Also, the Australian Government Small Business Superannuation Clearing House is a free service open to small businesses with less than 20 employees.
