SUPERANNUATION CLEARING HOUSE

As part of the Payday Super reform, the Small Business Clearing House (SBSCH) will close on 1 July 2026. To support small businesses to transition to alternative services prior to this time, new users will be unable to register to use the service from 1 October 2025. Existing users are encouraged to take steps now to transition to alternative options. These include reviewing your existing software and payroll packages, which may already include super functions, or looking at options offered by super funds, commercial clearing houses, or other payroll software or providers.
