^Important information about reinstating your insurance cover

If you apply to have your cover reinstated within 60 days of cover being cancelled, your cover will be reinstated from the date it was cancelled and there will be no gaps in cover.

It is a requirement that you are not aware of any condition or related symptom that is likely to be a terminal illness or is likely to result in total and permanent disablement. If you are not At Work on the date cover is reinstated, your reinstated cover will be Limited Cover until you are again At Work for 30 consecutive days.

Any restrictions, conditions, exclusions or premium loadings that were previously applied to your cover will continue to apply to your reinstated cover.
