Significant Event Notice – Australian Ethical Super –Risk Level and Strategic Asset Allocation changes

We're letting you know that we've made changes to our product. The changes include:

- 1. Reduction to the Standard Risk Measure that applies to some Super and Pension Investment options
- 2. Changes to the Strategic Asset Allocation targets for some investment options

We've provided more details on these changes below.

Reduction to the Risk Levels

Each of our investment options has a risk label that has been evaluated using the Standard Risk Measure ("SRM", see Table on next page). The SRM is based on industry guidance as to the likely number of negative annual returns expected over any 20 year period. Its purpose is to provide members with a label to assist in comparing investment options both within and across superannuation funds using a simplified risk measure. It is not a complete assessment of all forms of investment risk. For instance, it does not detail what the size of a negative return could be or the potential for a positive return to be less than you may require to meet your objectives. Further, it does not take into account the impact of administration fees and tax. You should still ensure you are comfortable with the risks and potential losses associated with your chosen investment option(s).
